Our Course Fee is inclusive of VTCT registration fees. We pay these to VTCT and they are non-refundable.

What you can expect.

Learners are provided with training and assessment in:

1. Practical Thai Massage Techniques
2. Customer service
3. Health & Safety at work

Learning includes the anatomy and physiology of the human body. This is a necessary foundation for learning massage techniques.

1. Learners will be expected to attend classes and workshop sessions. Course duration is dependent on:
 - The guided hours required by VTCT
 - The ability and commitment of individual learners
2. Learners are expected to complete written assignments and case studies. Responsibility for learning rests with each individual learner. Our Centre provides training that includes advice and guidance on how best to achieve the expected outcomes.
3. Learners will also be expected to attend periodic assessments. These will be conducted at the Centre by internal and/or external colleagues. Learners will be provided with a copy of our:
 - Complaints procedure
 - Appeals procedure
4. Refunds are not normally available. In the event of a learner requiring a refund, an exit interview will be conducted to assess the circumstances, including the reason a refund is required. At this time, we will consider the amount of training time already provided, along with resources supplied.
5. Where we hold learner portfolios for assessment, learners issued with a refund cannot expect to have these returned.
6. A minimum administration fee of £200 applies in all circumstances.
7. Once we have registered a learner with VTCT, these terms and conditions apply.
